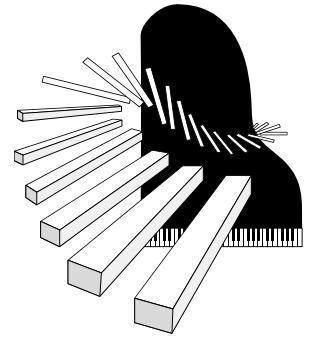




OMTA Contemporary Music Festival

Your OMTA Chapter is pleased to announce the second of three student recitals for the 2007 - 2008 school year.

The Contemporary Music Festival will be held at the First Methodist Church, 1224 Legion Way SE (at the intersection of Legion and Boundary) in Olympia, Saturday afternoon, the 16th of February 2008. Recital times will depend on final enrollment, but are tentatively set for 1 PM, 2:15 PM, and 3:30 PM.

The recital is open to all students of member teachers, including voice, strings, winds, brass, percussion and of course, piano.

The musical selections should be Contemporary classical in nature, generally representing composers who lived or composed in either the 20th or 21st centuries.

It is preferred that students have their performance music memorized, but if they have learned a piece, but memorization is not quite there (after all, it is early in the year), they may use their music. Please indicate memorization status on the application form. Thank you.

In addition to solo repertoire, consider duets, trios, etc., including two-student duets and student-teacher duets. Many times, timid performers will be okay with performing as a team.

Student enrollment is due by February 1st. There is a small enrollment fee of \$5 for each performer. Certificates and other awards will be handed out to performers at the end of each recital.

Teachers, you all know and recognize how valuable public performance is for students of the musical arts. Please enroll as many students as you can, at every level. This is also a great opportunity for young students to hear older, maturing musicians, which can serve as a source of inspiration for them.
